**Re: Italy 2010 – Tri Nations – Brief Itinerary**

In preparation for the trip to Italy and the tri-nations event, the Committee would like to inform you of an outline of the travel arrangements.

Squad and staff members should meet on the evening of 14 June 2010 at the Travel Lodge Great Dunmow, near Stansted Airport, at around 20:30hrs. Can I ask that you contact Stuart Irwin to confirm attendance prior to that date.

The flight to Italy leaves Stansted at 06:40hrs with check in at least two hours before, and travels to Milan Bergamo, arriving at 09:35hrs.

Transport and accommodation are being organised by our Italian colleagues, as is the match itinerary, but we will play both the French and Italian Fire Services in a round robin format, culminating in an awards event at the end of the tour.

Please note, the Committee has secured sponsorship for flights to be paid for, however travel insurance is not contained within the package we have negotiated. Please ensure you have a valid passport before travel and your baggage allowance is one bag weighing no more than the 15kg.

It is very important to note the tour members are representing the British Fire Service and although we all aim to have an enjoyable experience, all traveling members are expected to conduct themselves appropriately and with due regard to our hosts and the facilities they offer. To that end, every member will be expected to sign a code of conduct agreement prior to departure, which reinforces that understanding.

I have had a number of enquiries regarding dress code, specifically around attendance at the awards event, and am conscious that not all members of the squad had the opportunity earlier in the year to receive specific player apparel. Could I therefore confirm that the dress code for the awards event etc., will be jacket/blazer and tie.

Can I wish you all the very best from the Committee who are to be present, when possible, in Italy.
